#### **Companion Planting for Potatoes**

One way to boost the yield and flavour of your crop is to plant other species alongside or amongst your potatoes.

#### Good companions:

Examples of crops that are beneficial, either through increasing disease resistance or repelling pests are:

Horseradish, garlic and onions which produce pest repelling odours and chemicals.

Peas or beans are good nitrogen fixers in the soil, will provide shade and help prevent moisture loss.

**Corn** is a good companion plant as it will grow above the potatoes providing shade and helping to prevent the soil drying out.

#### Friends best kept at a distance:

Any of the **brassica** family (other than horseradish), as these do not enjoy the same growing conditions—brassicas do best in a slightly alkaline soil, whereas potatoes prefer a more acidic mix. **Tomatoes**, **cucumbers** and **squashes** may make the potatoes more susceptible to blight and disease.



#### Harvesting and storing onions/garlic

- As soon as the leaves start to yellow and die back, onions and garlic are ready for harvesting. Don't bend over the leaves to speed this up.
- Lay the bulbs, complete with foliage, in a warm, dry place for a couple of weeks to dry out. If onions develop thick necks use these straight away as they don't store well and are prone to neck rot.
- Make sure the foliage is completely dry before storing the crop in a dark, cool, dry place, either by hanging in nets or plaits, or packing carefully in layers in boxes. Storage life depends on the cultivar but is usually 3-6 months.
